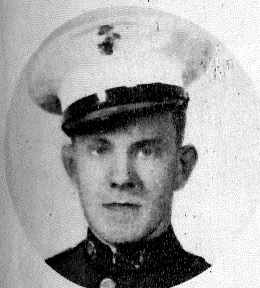
Ensign Warner H. Paige Jr., son of

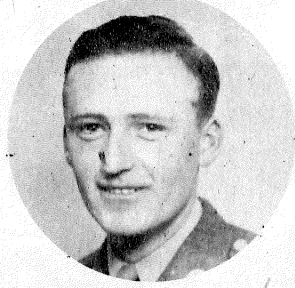

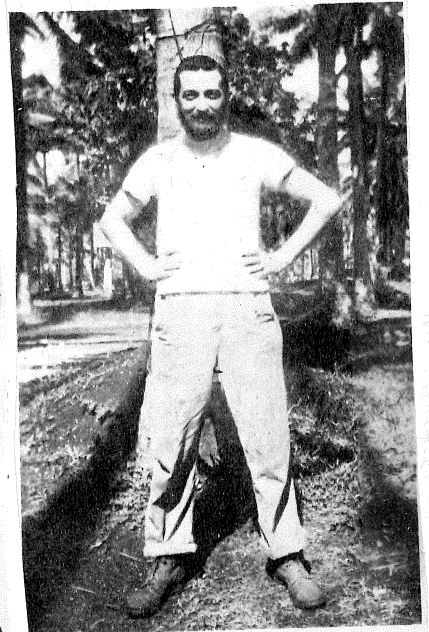

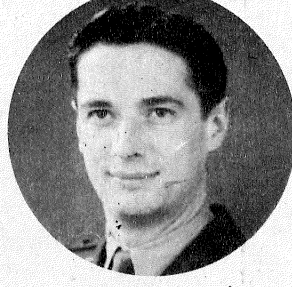
